



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2020-27

AN ORDER PRESCRIBING THE RULES GOVERNING ALL ACTIVITIES RELATING TO THE
OBSERVANCE OF UNDAS 2020 IN ALL PRIVATE AND PUBLIC CEMETERIES AND MEMORIAL
PARKS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF PURA, TARLAC

WHEREAS, Section 2 of Proclamation # 922, which was issued by the President of the Philippines declaring a state of public health emergency throughout the Philippines, mandated that all government agencies and LGUs to render full assistance and cooperation and mobilize the necessary resources to undertake critical, urgent and appropriate response and measures in a timely manner to curtail and eliminate the spread of corona virus;

WHEREAS, on September 17, 2020, the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases issued Resolution No. 72, providing for the rules governing all activities relating to the observance of UNDAS 2020 in all private and public cemeteries and memorial parks throughout the Philippines until 15 November 2020;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Pura adopts the abovementioned IATF Resolution for the observance of UNDAS 2020;

NOW THEREFORE, I FREDDIE D. DOMINGO, Mayor of the Municipality of Pura, and by virtue of the powers and authority vested in me by law, do hereby order and decree the following operational rules and regulations:

SECTION 1. CEMETERY OPERATIONS/TEMPORARY CLOSURE/APPLICABILITY. All private and public cemeteries and memorial parks in the Municipality of Pura shall be closed to the public from October 29, 2020 to November 04, 2020.

SECTION 2. PERMISSIBLE VISITS TO CEMETERIES. Individuals intending to visit private and public cemeteries and memorial parks in the Municipality of Pura are enjoined to visit before or after the temporary closure of these establishments. Provided that, the number of visitors shall be limited to a maximum of 30% of the venue capacity and observance of minimum health protocols like wearing of face masks and face shields and observance of physical distancing.


SECTION 3. VIOLATIONS. Violation of any provision in the Executive Order and other Executive Orders issued in relation to the COVID-19 pandemic, shall be subject to penalty pursuant to existing laws and local ordinances, without prejudice to the revocation of any special permit or business permits issued, and the closure of the business establishment.

SECTION 4. ENFORCEMENT. The Municipality of Pura Police Station, Pura Fire Station, Rural Health Unit, Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management

Permits and Licensing Office with the assistance of barangay officials and those assigned by the Municipal Mayor are hereby directed to implement this Order.

SECTION 5. INCORPORATION CLAUSE. All laws, legal orders, rules and regulations that have been issued and/or will be issued by the duly constituted authorities of the Republic of the Philippines, particularly the IATF, pertaining to public health and COVID-19 are hereby incorporated herein and made integral parts hereof.

SECTION 6. SEPARABILITY CALUSE. If any part or provision of this Executive Order is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the other provisions not affected shall remain valid and subsisting.

SECTION 7. REPEALING CLAUSE. All issuances inconsistent herewith are hereby superseded accordingly.

SECTION 8. EFFECTIVITY. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately after signing hereof and shall remain in force until November 15, 2020 unless sooner revoked, superseded or modified by subsequent Executive Order and other issuances.
