



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2020-31

AN ORDER PRESCRIBING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF THE PURA PUBLIC MARKET
ON DECEMBER 25, 2020 AND JANUARY 01, 2021

WHEREAS, Section 2 of Proclamation # 922, which was issued by the President of the Philippines declaring a state of public health emergency throughout the Philippines, mandated that all government agencies and LGUs to render full assistance and cooperation and mobilize the necessary resources to undertake critical, urgent and appropriate response and measures in a timely manner to curtail and eliminate the spread of corona virus;

WHEREAS, on October 08, 2020, the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases issued OMNIBUS GUIDELINES ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF COMMUNITY QUARANTINE IN THE PHILIPPINES;

WHEREAS, in keeping with the duty of the Local Government to promote health, safety general welfare of its constituents, as enshrined in Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, the Municipality of Pura strictly adheres to the abovementioned guidelines and other COVID related issuances;

NOW THEREFORE, I **FREDDIE D. DOMINGO**, Mayor of the Municipality of Pura, and by virtue of the powers and authority vested in me by law, do hereby order and decree the following operational rules and regulations:

SECTION 1. TEMPORARY CLOSURE/APPLICABILITY. The Pura Public Market **shall be closed to the public on December 25, 2020 and January 01, 2021.**

SECTION 2. PERMISSIBLE ESTABLISHMENTS. Private groceries not within the premises of the public market may opt to conduct business on the said dates, provided that, observance of minimum health protocols like wearing of face masks and face shields and physical distancing shall be strictly enforced.

SECTION 3. VIOLATIONS. Violation of any provision in the Executive Order and other Executive Orders issued in relation to the COVID-19 pandemic, shall be subject to penalty pursuant to existing laws and local ordinances, without prejudice to the revocation of any special permit or business permits issued, and the closure of the business establishment.


SECTION 4. ENFORCEMENT. The Municipality of Pura Police Station, Pura Fire Station, Rural Health Unit, Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office and the Business

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Permits and Licensing Office with the assistance of barangay officials and those assigned by the Municipal Mayor are hereby directed to implement this Order.

SECTION 5. INCORPORATION CLAUSE. All laws, legal orders, rules and regulations that have been issued and/or will be issued by the duly constituted authorities of the Republic of the Philippines, particularly the IATF, pertaining to public health and COVID-19 are hereby incorporated herein and made integral parts hereof.

SECTION 6. SEPARABILITY CALUSE. If any part or provision of this Executive Order is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the other provisions not affected shall remain valid and subsisting.

SECTION 7. REPEALING CLAUSE. All issuances inconsistent herewith are hereby superseded accordingly.

SECTION 8. EFFECTIVITY. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately after signing hereof and shall remain in force unless sooner revoked, superseded or modified by subsequent Executive Order and other issuances.
