APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 002

Series of 2020

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO. 02, SERIES OF 2020, INVOLVING THE AMOUNT OF SEVEN MILLION TWO HUNDRED SIX THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED THIRTY EIGHT PESOS (P 7,206,538.00) FROM THE BAYANIHAN GRANT TO THE MUNICIPALITY

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 11469, otherwise known as the “*Bayanihan to Heal as One Act*”, granted the president the power to adopt various temporary emergency measures to respond to crisis brought by the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic;

WHEREAS, the *Bayanihan Grant To Cities and Municipalities* (BGCM), pursuant to the above-mentioned law, amounting to SEVEN MILLION TWO HUNDRED SIX THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED THIRTY EIGHT PESOS (P7,206,538.00) was released in favor of the Municipality of Pura to boost its capacity in immediate responding to the COVID-19 emergency;

NOW THEREFORE, on unanimous motion, be it enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan, that:

SECTION 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as “Supplemental Budget No. 02”;

SECTION 2. SOURCE OF FUNDS. The source of funds for the Supplemental Budget in the total amount of **SEVEN MILLION TWO HUNDRED SIX THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED THIRTY EIGHT PESOS (P7,206,538.00)** shall be as follows:

SECTION 4. CREATION OF SPECIAL ACCOUNT. Pursuant to Section 3.7 of the Department of Budget and Management Local Budget Circular No. 125, dated April 7, 2020, the Chief Executive is hereby authorized to create a Special Account in the General Fund for the BGCM.

In this regard, the Local Chief Executive, together with the Municipal Treasurer, is hereby authorized to open a Bank Account at Land Bank of the Philippines for the BGCM.

SECTION 5. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If for any reason, any section or provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, other sections or provisions thereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and affect.
