**RESOLUTION NO. 66**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE LOCAL CHIEF EXECUTIVE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND EMPLOYMENT (DOLE) REGIONAL OFFICE NO. III FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF KABUHAYAN PROGRAM (STARTER KIT)**

WHEREAS, the current Administration has directed all cabinet members to immediately implement poverty reduction projects in all regions;

WHEREAS, the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) is mandated to promote gainful opportunities, develop human resources, protect workers and promote their welfare, and maintain industrial peace;

WHEREAS, the DOLE endeavors to contribute to reducing poverty and vulnerability to risks of the poor, vulnerable and marginalized workers by providing them access to livelihood undertakings;

WHEREAS, the DOLE will provide a capacity building facility on livelihood and entrepreneurial ventures for the workers in the informal economy and the vulnerable groups of workers such as parents of child laborers, women, youth, persons with disabilities, indigenous people, among others, under the DOLE LIVELIHOOD (KABUHAYAN) PROGRAM, pursuant to the provision of DO No. 137-14, Series of 2014;

WHEREAS, the DOLE - RO No. III has been given the responsibility to implement the DOLE Livelihood (Kabuhayan) Program to Livelihood/Enterprise Formation (STARTER KIT).

1. Livelihood/Enterprise Formation

Enable the unemployed poor, seasonal and low- wage workers to start individual livelihood or collective enterprise undertakings with the goal of moving them out of poverty and making them productive,

2. Livelihood/Enterprise Formation Enhancement

Enable the existing livelihood undertakings of self- employed workers to grow into viable and sustainable businesses that provide income at least at par with minimum wage earners. For the low-wage workers, it will give them opportunity to augment their income.

WHEREAS, DOLE- RO No. III shall implement the foregoing livelihood intervention in the Municipality of Pura, Province of Tarlac, in partnership with the Local Government Unit of Pura as accredited co-partner;

WHEREAS, this partnership is vital to ensure the successful implementation of the said projects and achieve their desired social outcomes;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of Pura has been accredited by DOLE to be capable and experienced in implementing the proposed project of Livelihood Project on Kabuhayan Starter Kits located in Pura, Tarlac;

NOW THEREFORE, on unanimous motion presented, be it:

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to authorize the Local Chief Executive to enter into an agreement, for and in behalf of this Local Government Unit, with the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) Regional Office No. 3 for the implementation of the Kabuhayan Program (Starter Kit).

RESOLVED FURTHER, that copies of this resolution be forwarded to the Local Chief Executive and the Regional Director, Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE), Regional Office No. 3, Maimpis, City of San Fernando, Pampanga, for their information and guidance.
