A RESOLUTION REALIGNING THE AMOUNT OF ONE MILLION ONE HUNDRED NINETY THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED FORTY FOUR PESOS AND 19/100 CENTAVOS (P 1,190,244.19) FROM SAVINGS IN THE PERSONAL SERVICES OF THE MUNICIPALITY FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE FOURTH TRANCHE OF THE COMPENSATION ADJUSTMENT OF ALL QUALIFIED MUNICIPAL OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES

WHEREAS, the President of the Republic of the Philippines signed Executive Order No. 201, S. 2016 on February 19, 2016, entitled “*Modification of Schedule for Civilian Government Personnel and Authorizing the Grant of Additional Benefits for both Civilian and Military and Uniformed Personnel*”;

WHEREAS, the purpose of Executive Order No. 201 is to ensure that the compensation structure of government personnel be comparable with the prevailing rates in the private sector thereby attracting and retaining competent and committed civil servants;

WHEREAS, Section 2 of the Executive Order states that the modified Salary Schedule authorized therein shall apply to all civilian personnel in the Executive, Legislative and Judicial Branches, Constitutional Commissions and other Constitutional Offices, Government-Owned or Controlled Corporations (GOCCs) not covered by Republic Act No. 10149, and Local Government Units (LGUs), regardless of appointment status, whether regular, contractual or casual; appointive or elective; and on full time or part-time basis;

WHEREAS, the Department of Budget and Management issued Local Budget Circular No. 118 dated January 15, 2019 to prescribe the guidelines, rules and regulations for the implementation of the fourth tranche compensation adjustment in local government units (LGUs) stipulated under EO No. 201, s. 2016.

WHEREAS, the members of the Sangguniang Bayan, after careful deliberation, recommends the Implementation of the Fourth Tranche Compensation Adjustment for all qualified Local Government Personnel;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Councilor Timoteo D. Balmores, be it:

RESOLVED, as it hereby resolved, to realign the amount of **ONE MILLION ONE HUNDRED NINETY THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED FORTY FOUR PESOS AND 19/100 CENTAVOS (P 1,190,244.19)** from Savings in the Personal Services for the implementation of the Fourth Tranche Compensation Adjustment of the all qualified Municipal Officials and Employees;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that Compensation Adjustment for Local Government Personnel shall be retroactive January 1, 2019; (A copy of the pertinent Compensation Adjustment Schedule for Local Government Personnel is appended herewith and forms part of this Resolution.)

RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish copies of this resolution all concerned offices/agencies for their information and appropriation action.
