RESOLUTION NO. 046

Series of 2018

A RESOLUTION VEHEMENTLY URGING THE MUNICIPAL MAYOR AND/OR THE MUNICIPAL SOCIAL WELFARE AND DEVELOPMENT OFFICE (MSWD) TO ASSIST SENIOR CITIZEN ORGANIZATIONS IN PURA IN CONDUCTING A GENERAL ASSEMBLY FOR PURPOSES OF NOMINATING CANDIDATES FOR APPOINTMENT AS OSCA HEAD

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the FEDERATION OF SENIOR CITIZENS ASSOCIATION OF PURA, INCORPORATED (FSCAP for brevity) issued Board Resolution No. 3, Series of 2018, entitled “A Resolution Requesting the Honorable Mayor Concepcion Zarate, M.D., and the Sangguniang Bayan of Pura, the removal of OSCA Head, Mr. Marcelino D. Ayson, for Violation of R.A. 9994”;

WHEREAS, after series of inquiries by the Sangguniang Bayan, it was discovered that Mr. Marcelino D. Ayson was appointed and assumed his office as OSCA Head sometime February 2011 by Municipal Mayor Hon. Concepcion Zarate. It was further discovered that Mr. Ayson is still holding the said position;

WHEREAS; Section 2, Rule VI, of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9994, otherwise known as “Expanded Senior Citizens Act of 2017”, states:

“Section 2. Selection and Term of OSCA Head. - The OSCA Head shall be chosen from a list of three (3) nominees as recommended by a general assembly of DSWD-accredited or LGU-registered senior citizens organizations in the city or municipality. He/she shall be appointed by the mayor for a term of three (3) years without reappointment but without prejudice to an extension not exceeding three (3) months, if exigency so requires.”

WHEREAS, pursuant to the above-quoted provision of the law, it is clear that there is a necessity to nominate and appoint a new OSCA Head as the incumbent head is, by this time, holding the position for more than eight (8) years already;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan, deems it imperative that a General Assembly should be held for purposes, among others, of nominating candidates for appointment as OSCA Head by the Municipal Mayor;

NOW THEREFORE, on joint motion by the Chairman of the Committee on Women, Family and Social Welfare; and Chairman on Committee on Rules, Privileges and Legal Matters, it is hereby RESOLVED to URGE the Municipal Mayor and/or the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office to assist the FSCAP and other Senior Citizen Organizations recognized by the DSWD and/or the LGU of Pura in conducting a General Assembly for purposes of nominating candidates for appointment as OSCA Head by the Municipal Mayor;


RESOLVED FURTHER, to furnish copies of this resolution to the Office of the Municipal Mayor, Office of the MSWD, the Federation of Senior Citizens Association of Pura (FSCAP), and all other agencies and entities who may be affected by virtue hereof.
