RESOLUTION NO. 066

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE “F1+BNB” AT THE RURAL HEALTH UNIT OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF PURA

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 9502, otherwise known as the Universally Accessible Cheaper and Quality Medicine Act of 2008, mandates to protect public health and, when public interest or circumstances so requires, the State shall adopt appropriate measures to promote and ensure affordable quality drugs medicines for all;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 10918, otherwise known as the Philippine Pharmacy Act, recognizes the vital role of Pharmacist in the delivery of quality healthcare services thereby the pharmacist’s professional services shall therefore be promoted as an indispensable component of the total healthcare system to ensure the physical well-being of the Filipinos;

WHEREAS, the Department of Health (DOH) established the *Botika ng Barangay* (BnB) program in 2004. The program was successful in improving medicines access to previously deprived areas until the DOH issued a moratorium in January 2011 on the establishment of additional BnBs until such time that the system problems are solved;

WHEREAS, the National Government recognizes the importance of access to medicines as part of the fundamental human right to health and the socio-economic agenda to achieve Universal Health Care;

WHEREAS, pursuant to AO No. 2018-0014, the DOH aims to attain the goals outlined in the Philippine Development Plan 2017-2022 and build on the concept of *FourMULA* One Plus for Health

thereby expands the four pillars of health reforms and highlights greater focus on performance accountability towards the Filipino people;
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WHEREAS, the Government pledged to revitalize the “*Botika ng Bayan*” and pledged to ensure a holistic, whole-of-systems approach in the implementation of improving the supply chain management integration with other health and social services of the national government and institutionalizing good pharmacy practice to improve the quality of services;

WHEREAS, the National Government aims to establish partnerships with Local Governments, Medical Center Chief of Uniformed Personnel, Hospitals and other government agencies in implementing the F1+ BNB and F1+ BNBi program

NOW THEREFORE, on motion by Councilor Rebhenjer J. Caratiquit, duly seconded, it is hereby **RESOLVED** to **AUTHORIZE** the **ESTABLISHMENT OF THE “F1+BNB” AT THE RURAL HEALTH UNIT OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF PURA** and to **AUTHORIZE** the Local Chief Executive to enter into an agreement with the National Government in connection thereto;

RESOLVED, FURTHER to furnish copies of this resolution to all persons and agencies concerned.
